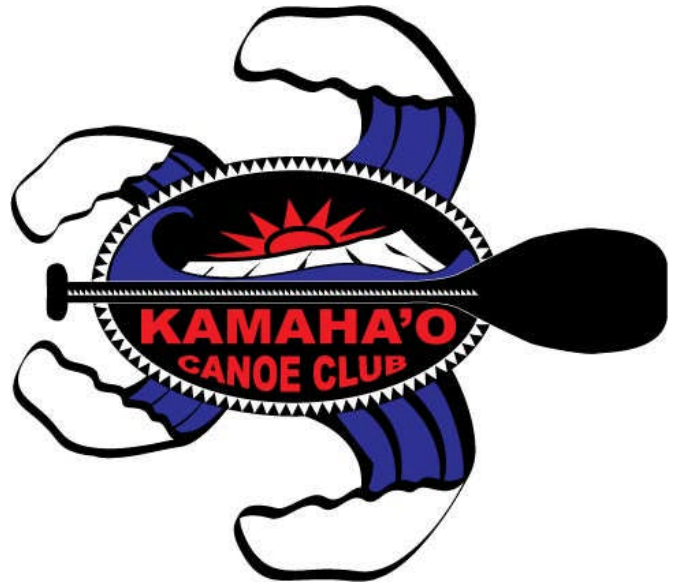


# The Kamaha'o Great Relay Race

### Course

Leg 1: Waterfront at Pu'uloa to buoys and return – 5.5 mi. – Wahine crews

Leg 2: Waterfront at Pu'uloa to bouys and return – 5 mi. – Mix crews

Leg 3: Waterfront at Pu'uloa to buoys and return – 8 mi. – Kane crews
